Vladimir Komovich was born in Krasnoyarsk, Russia. Since 2017 he has been a soloist of the Bolshoi Theater Opera Company.

In 2013 he graduated from the Krasnoyarsk State Academy of Music and Theater (class of V. Efimov). While still a student, he became a member of the Krasnoyarsk State Opera and Ballet Theatre, where he debuted as Luka Zinovich in Rimsky-Korsakov's Sadko. Then, after graduating from the Academy, Vladimir joined the Opera Company of the Krasnoyarsk Theater as a soloist. He toured frequently with the Opera Company in the Krasnoyarsk region.

In 2014 he trained at the creative laboratory for young singers "Siberian solo" (Krasnoyarsk); He participated in master classes with Carlos Álvares, Yusif Eivazov, Nikola Pamio and soloists from the Bolshoi Theater. In 2015 he studied at the "Collegio di Milano" (A. Gusev's class).

In the 2016-17 season, Vladimir became a member of the Young Artists Program of the Bolshoi Theater. He made his debut at the Bolshoi Theater in the premiere of Puccini's Manon Lescaut singing the role of the Naval Captain (director Jader Bignamini, director Adolf Shapiro).
