After graduating with maximum distinction with a Bachelor's Degree in Music Theory at the University of Chile, Bruno Vargas began his studies in Singing at the Catholic University of Chile with Rodrigo del Pozo and Sergio Gómez. At this time he joined the Choir of the Municipal Theater of Santiago as a stable member.

With the help of the Culture and Arts Council of the Chilean Ministry of Culture, he settled in Essen in Germany, where he continued his studies with Jan-Hendrik Rootering and Wolfgang Millgramm. He was also awarded a scholarship by the Richard Wagner Association of Dortmund.

As an opera soloist he has sung more than 40 roles (such as Sarastro, Sparafucile, Don Alfonso or Filippo II, among others) in Germany, Italy, Austria and Switzerland. Between 2015 and 2017 he was part of the Opera Studio of the Hamburg State Opera, a theater in which he continued to be invited to sing as a soloist. Among the German theaters where he has performed as a soloist, the Deutsche Oper am Rhein, Theater Schwerin, Theater Dortmund and Theater Bremen stand out. He has been able to work with internationally famous directors such as Kent Nagano, Gabriele Ferro, Renato Palumbo and Roberto Rizzi-Brignoli, among others.

Bruno Vargas has continued to perfect himself with singers such as Christian Senn, Luis Olivares and Ramón Vargas in addition to cultivating his passion for German Lied as an active student in Master Classes by teachers such as Thomas Quasthoff, Angelika Kirschlager, Bo Skovhus or the pianist Gerold Huber. As an Oratorio singer he has sung important works: Mendelssohn's Elías, Bach's St. Matthew Passion or Mozart's Requiem among others.
